The Safety Codes and Standards Medal, established by the Council on Codes and Standards in 1986, is presented to one individual on an annual basis, an individual who has contributed to the enhancement of public safety through the development and promotion of ASME Codes and Standards or the ASME safety accreditation activity. The award consists of an enamel medal, an embossed certificate, and \$1500 honorarium.

The Board on Safety Codes and Standards has established a Safety Codes and Standards Medal Committee that considers nominations received from members serving on safety codes and standards committees, as well as suggestions from outside sources. Their recommendation for the recipient of the award is then submitted for the consideration of the ASME Committee on Honors. Proposers of nominees who are not selected will be so advised by the BSCS Secretary. At this time, the proposers will be requested to advise the Secretary if they wish to nominate the same individual for the following year's medal. If they elect to nominate the same individual, proposers will be given the opportunity to provide additional information with regard to the nominee's qualifications.
